75% Zinfandel, 23% Shiraz, 2% Petite Sirah

**ZINFANDEL**

The 2004 Painter Bridge Zinfandel comes from a mix of Zinfandel grown in Paso Robles and in other select California winegrowing regions, blended with a couple spicy varieties – Shiraz and Petite Sirah

The stylistic goal of Painter Bridge Zinfandel is to emphasize the tremendous red fruit characters of the Zinfandel grape without overpowering the delicacy of the fruit with oak. The varieties blended into the Zinfandel each contribute a flavor and spice component that accentuates and broadens the resultant wine.

**WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS**

The 2004 Painter Bridge Zinfandel shows great color density with youthful purple hues. The aromas are enticing spicy, jammy red fruits: raspberry, boysenberry and red currants with a black tea spice. The palate delivers a full, yet supple wine with great raspberry Zinfandel fruit presence and richness of flavor richness. Enjoy with your favorite pasta dishes and grilled meats. Serve at around 62°F.
